



# 2021 Census: UK armed forces veterans data for Suffolk

A first look at the results for Suffolk County and our Districts and Boroughs. The source of all the data presented is the 2021 Census.


### **Key points:**

- At the time of the 2021 Census, there were 30,976 UK armed forces veterans resident in Suffolk. This equates to 4.9% of people aged 16+ resident in the county; two percentage points higher than the England and Wales average of 2.9%.
- Of these, 24,371 previously served in the UK regular armed forces (3.9% of residents aged 16+), 5,202 previously served in UK reserve armed forces (0.8%) and 1,403 (0.2%) previously served in both of these forces.
- Around 1 in every 11 households in Suffolk is home to a UK armed forces veteran.



- At the time of the 2021 Census, there were 30,976 UK armed forces veterans resident in Suffolk. This equates to 4.9% of people aged 16+ resident in the county (almost 1 in 20); two percentage points higher than the England and Wales average of 2.9%.
- Of these, 24,371 previously served in the UK regular armed forces (3.9% of residents aged 16+), 5,202 previously served in UK reserve armed forces (0.8%) and 1,403 (0.2%) previously served in both of these forces.



- All of Suffolk's Districts and Boroughs have a higher percentage of residents who served in the UK armed forces than the England and Wales average.
- Among Suffolk's Districts and Boroughs, the largest number of residents who previously served in the UK armed forces is in East Suffolk (11,292). This equates to 5.4% of the resident population aged 16+; the highest proportion of any District and Borough in Suffolk.
- Babergh has the lowest number of former UK armed forces residents (3,832), while Ipswich has the smallest proportion of resident veterans (3.9%).





• 8.7% of households in Suffolk are home to a UK armed forces veteran. This is higher than the England and Wales average of 7.1%.



- All of Suffolk's Districts and Boroughs contain a larger proportion of households that have at least one UK armed forces veteran as a member than across the East of England or England and Wales.
- Almost 1 in 10 households in Mid Suffolk (9.8%) has a UK armed forces veteran member the highest proportion of any Suffolk District or Borough.
- The lowest proportion of households containing a UK armed forces veteran is in Ipswich (6.8%).

Dataset description: This dataset provides Census 2021 estimates that classify usual residents in England and Wales by whether or not they have previously served in the UK armed forces. The estimates are as at Census Day, 21 March 2021.

Variable Description: Identifies people who have previously served in the UK armed forces. This includes those who have served for at least one day in armed forces, either regular or reserves, or Merchant Mariners who have seen duty on legally defined military operations.

Dataset description: This dataset provides Census 2021 estimates that classify households in England and Wales by the number of people in the household who have previously served in the UK armed forces. The estimates are as at Census Day, 21 March 2021.

Variable Description: Number of people in the household who have previously served in the UK armed forces. This includes those who have served for at least one day in armed forces, either regular, reserves or Merchant Mariners who have seen duty on legally defined military operations.

Dataset description: This dataset provides Census 2021 estimates that classify usual residents in England and Wales who have previously served in the UK armed forces by whether they reside in communal establishments and in households. The estimates are as at Census Day, 21 March 2021.

Variable Description: Whether a person lives in a household or a communal establishment. Communal Establishments include: hospitals, care homes, prisons, defence bases, boarding schools and student halls of residence.

People who completed the normal household questionnaire were recorded as living in a household. Those who completed an individual questionnaire were asked if they lived in a household or a communal establishment.
