





#### Developmental Work ∧

Look into the increasing issues of negative budgets, income volatility and people falling into deeper levels of poverty to identify potential additional actions.

Particular focus on groups in deepest levels of poverty (single adult households with and without children, disabled people, socially isolated people, people on lowincomes in social and private rented accomodation)



Look into whether there are any potential opportunities to address the issue of increasing social isolation caused by people struggling to afford essential costs and thus having to stop social activities.



Look into potential opportunities to improve access to educational and leisure opportunities for children and young people living in poverty



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
