Area Summary

Barnby is a village and parish that sits on the A146 between Lowestoft and Beccles on the Norfolk/Suffolk border. The area lends its name to a notorious stretch of the A146, known as the 'Barnby Bends.'

Barnby sits on top of its neighbouring parish of North Cove with which it shares a small primary school. The local Methodist church building (formerly village hall) recently closed and has since been put up for auction as a private residence.

The very north of the parish is taken up by the 'Barnby Broad and Marshes', an Site of Special Scientific Interest that is managed by Suffolk Wildlife Trust.

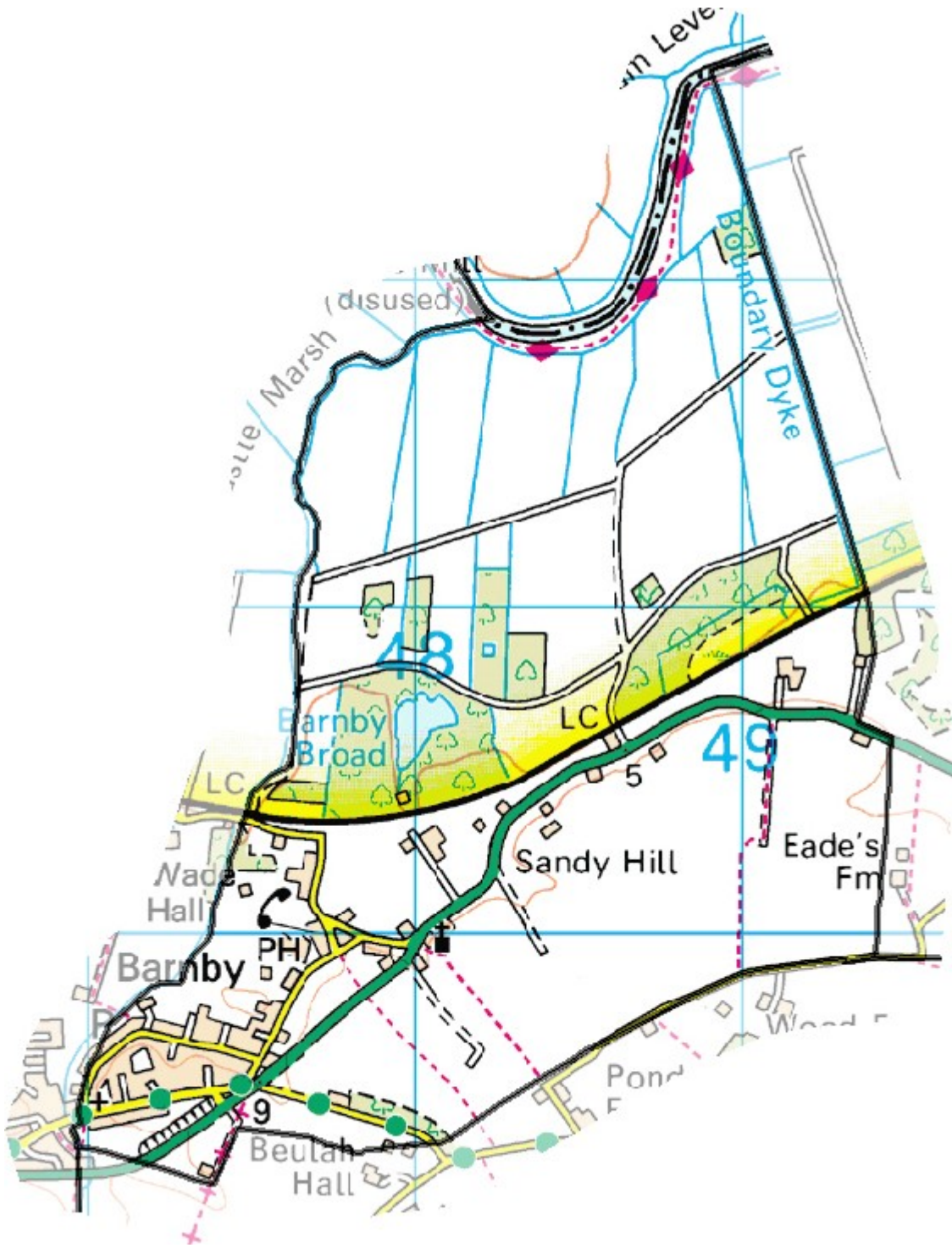
