Area Summary

Dalham is a village and civil parish in Forest Heath that sits 6 miles east of Newmarket and around 9 miles west of Bury St Edmunds. The village itself is in the west of the parish, while the smaller hamlet of Dunstall Green can be found to the east.

The village hosts a number of community assets. The village hall is relatively new having been built in 2010 following several years of fundraising. You will also find the local pub along the main street although it is set back on a different lane, separated from the main road by the River Kennett.

There are two historical landmarks in Dalham with a surviving windmill and Malting Kiln.

The north of the parish is occupied by Dalham Hall. The estate currently hosts the Dalham Hall Darley Stud which acts as the headquarters for a global thoroughbred racehorse operation.
