Area Summary

Redisham is a small village that can be found between Beccles and Halesworth in Waveney.

The area has very little in the way of local amenities or economic activity.

The parish church, one of the smallest in Suffolk, can be found alongside the majority of the parish's housing. The church's accessible location means it is used as a venue for local groups, including a coffee morning and a children's play group.

Redisham Hall shares the parish's name but, strangely, sits outside its boundary (in Ringsfield). Brampton train station is also close by but, again, lies outside of the parish boundary.

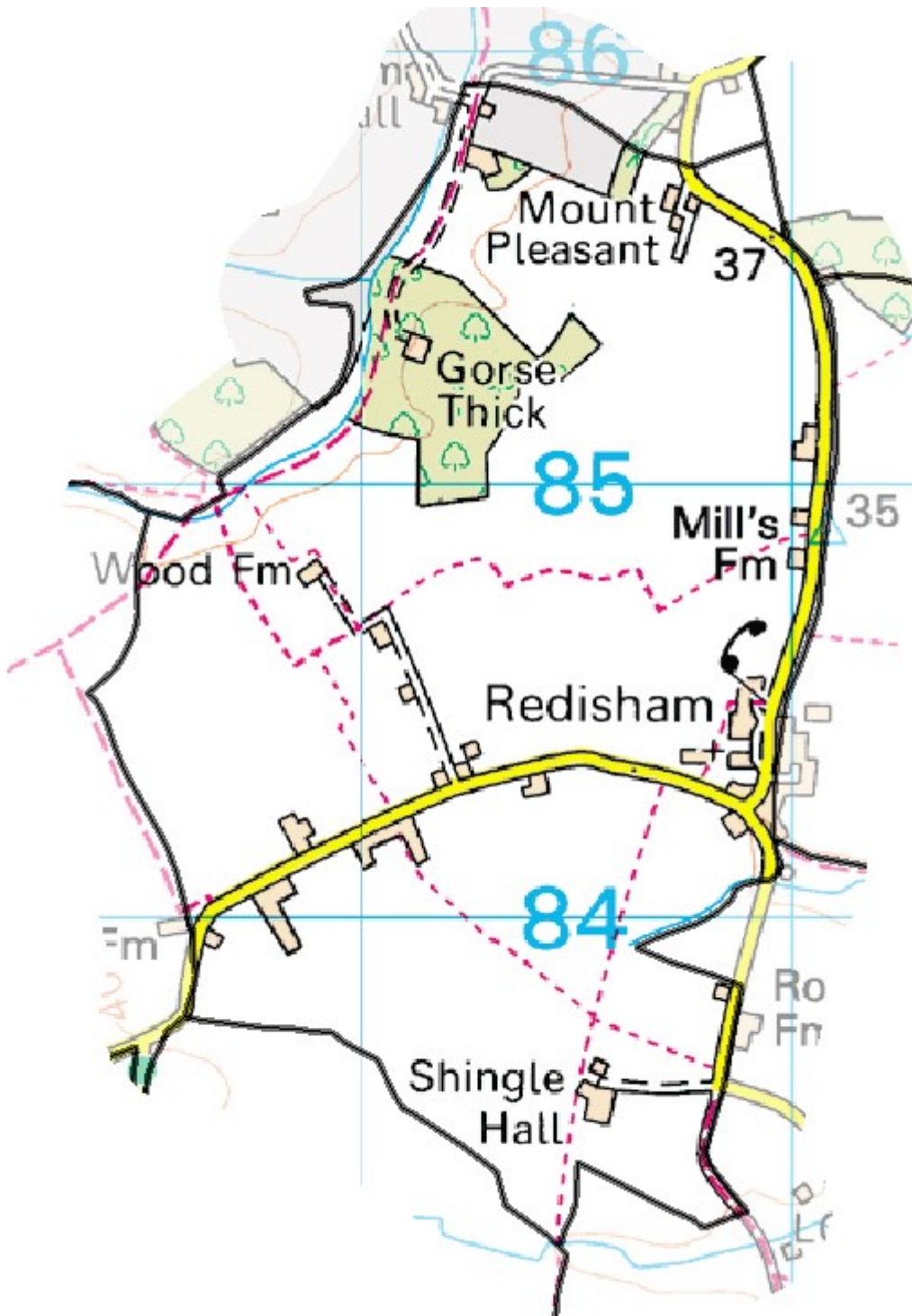
